### Trails Report

Since early September, Diego was quite busy for many days preparing for-, attending-, and putting away- for the three wonderful events - Day in the Country, Stetsons & Stilettos, and the Hunter Pace.

Meantime trees continued to fall all around town. He continued to mow Milliken's, fixed several matters near Kelsey's, in Conyers, and near Keefe's. The fallen tree on GLT property on Close Road was the biggest ever!

The area between Taconic and North Streets was cleared and mowed. The RHC area trails were mowed and cleared with one loose end for the Club to fix near Newell Rock. He inspected the underneath of the bridge near ex-McTaggart, fixed trouble on the trail north of Nives and cleared the Boys and Girls Club trails.

There was confusion on the new trail near the expanded cemetery next to the Boy Scouts and he was able to restore the diverted trail. There was more new cleanup work in the Sabine Farm, and Doverton Drive areas, as well as at Nichols—including a new trail to the right just inside the West Lane gate. Diego checked and fixed trails east of Kingdon's and north of Nemser's.

These were 4 weeks of intense work. Now Diego has time for your requests of catch-up or new work. He will soon go north of Farms Rd., then recheck numerous areas for fallen trees and debris which is ongoing. Fortunately, the burdens of seasonal weed-wacking are over.
